Respected sir,

Under section 18 of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education for Children Act – 2009 and in accordance with the right obtained under rule no. (5) (1) of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education for Children Act – 2012 and under Mumbai Primary Education Act – 1949 and on the basis of the online application received from your trust to start new non granted primary (lower/upper) school from June – 2021 and enclosures attached therewith, approval is sanctioned for addition of classes in non-granted private primary (lower/upper) school, class 6 to 8, subject to conditions mentioned hereunder;

Conditions:-

1. School Trust will be responsible to fulfill and maintain conditions for approval of school.
2. School Trust will be responsible to follow all provisions of the Right to Free and Compulsory Education for Children Act – 2009, the Right to Free and Compulsory Education for Children Act – 2012, Gujarat Primary Education Act – 1947 and Mumbai Primary Education Act – 1949.



3. School Trust will be responsible and abide to all the acts and rules formed under them, School Trust will also have to follow all rules, regulations, circulars, and resolutions, instructions etc. declared or ordered by the state government time to time.
4. School will have to give admission to the children of nearby deprived localities in the pre primary and Std. 1 to the extent of 25% of the total intake of the class. Free and Compulsory education must be provided to them till the end of their primary education. Concerned authorities shall have to be contacted for the implementation of the same.
5. Capitation fee is strictly prohibited and hence trust must not ask for any capitation fee or any donation or any other articles in lieu of the fees.
6. School will not have to exercise any Screening / Test of the children or their parents or guardian for the purpose of admission in school.
7. School must not reject admission to any child on the basis of lack of birth certificate or any evidence of any religion, caste, and creed or birth place.
8. School shall have to make sure that;
 1. Admitted child should not be kept on hold except in Std. 5 and Std. 8 until their primary education is over.
No child is rusticated or not followed up due process of class upgradation.
 2. No child becomes liable to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 3. Every child completing primary education is provided with certificate as stated under rule – 30.
 4. Children having disability or with special needs have to be given admission under due provisions of the act
 5. Recruitment of Teachers is done as per the qualifications specified by the government time to time.
 6. Student – Teacher Ratio is as per rules, Classroom measurement is as per rules and all necessary infrastructural facilities are provided.
 7. Teachers follow their duties as per Section – 24 (1) of the act.
 8. Teachers are not practicing private tuitions. It will be the responsibility of Board of Governors.
 9. Transparent and Neutral admission process is to be undertaken as per the rules and regulations of Central Govt., State Govt. and education department.
9. School will have to impart education on the basis of the syllabus structured by the concerned authorities.
10. School should give admission to the students considering the capacity of the school as specified in section 19.
11. School will have to maintain its standards as stated under section – 19. Moreover, maintenance of school website, providing true and accurate information to DISE and conditions related to rule – 13 have to be followed.
12. No unauthorized classes with the name of school should be conducted inside or outside the school.
13. School building and other amenities or ground have to be used only for the purpose of educational and skill building activities of the students.
14. School has to be operated by a trust/society registered under Society Registration Act – 1860 or any other prevailing act.
15. School must not be operated with profit motive for any person, group of persons or association of persons of the trust.
16. Account books of the school will have to be audited and certified by Chartered Accountant. Relevant and necessary books of accounts and other records will have to be maintained as per rules and a copy of audited accounts should be sent to the concerned authority every year.
17. School must have CCTV camera with recording facility available in the premises and concerned authority must be reported about it.
18. Necessary steps are to be taken as per the guidelines of National Disaster Management Authority within the given timeframe. School Safety Policy – 2016 must be implemented.
19. Fire Safety Clearance Certificate will have to be renewed periodically from the concerned authority.
20. School must ensure safety of students and staff by taking necessary safety standards.



21. School management shall neither compel any student/guardian to purchase specific books, literature, uniform or shoes with specific brand/logo from their associated institute or any specific agency nor will it insist to do so.
22. School will abide by the rules and regulations framed under GUJARAT SELF FINANCE SCHOOL FEE REGULATION ACT – 2017 and will have to submit undertaking statement to implement the same.
23. Officer with designated capacities or any person authorized by him and inspection officer of the education department shall have their right to inspect the school.
24. School will have to follow the syllabus and books approved by the government time to time.
25. Education fees and salaries of Teaching and Non-Teaching staff should be as per government norms.
26. Records, numerical statements and certificates provided by the principal of the school should be trustworthy and credible.
27. School shall provide reports and information as asked by the concerned authorities and education department. School will also follow orders of state government/local authority for maintaining standards to continue school approval.
28. No change can be made to the name of the school, address of the school or organizational structure of the school without the consent of the concerned officers.
29. School should be started in the year in which the approval is given. If the school will not be started within the six months of the receipt of approval then the approval will get cancelled automatically.
30. Building of the school shall be vacated and should be given for the public exams or public utilities whenever circumstances occur.
31. All resolutions/circulars/instructions/rules declared by the government time to time have to be followed.
32. This approval is given on the basis of the revenue and other evidence supports provided by you. If any information or evidence provided is found faulty in future, trust shall be held responsible and government will have power to exercise police complaint along with other law binding steps.

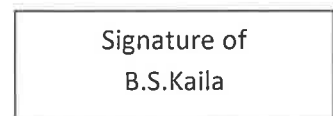
